It is my pleasure as ADEE President to welcome you to ADEE 2023 Liverpool.**

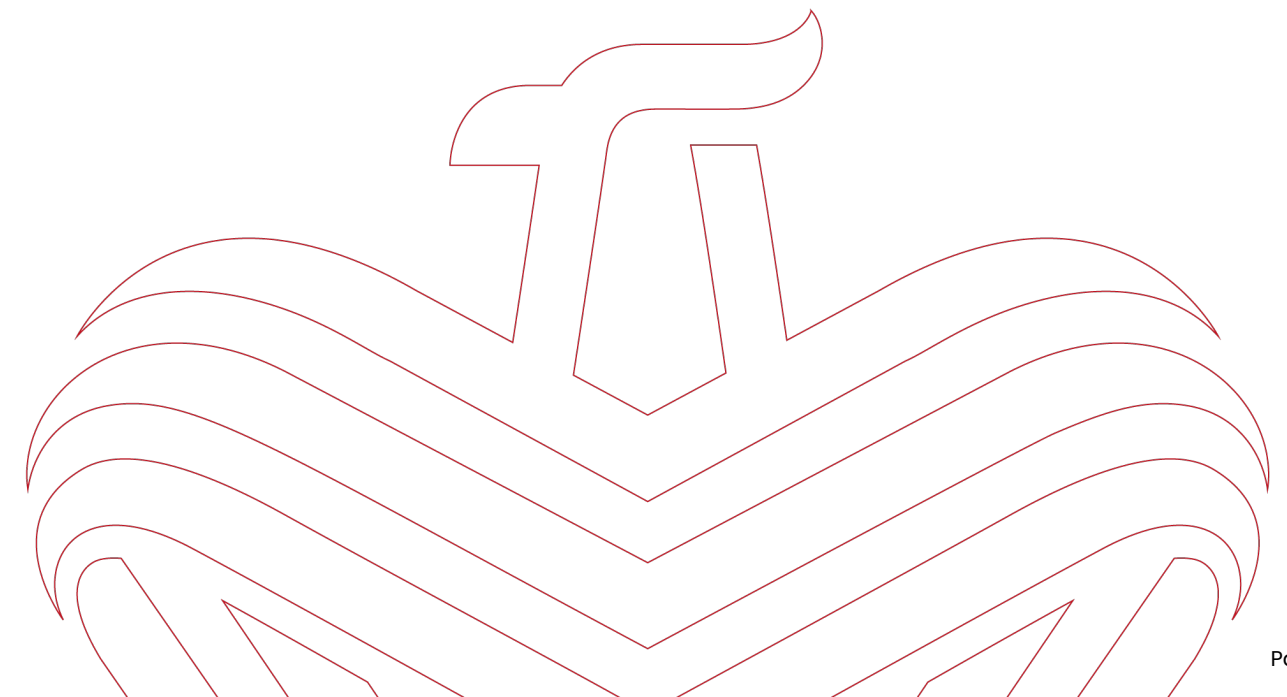

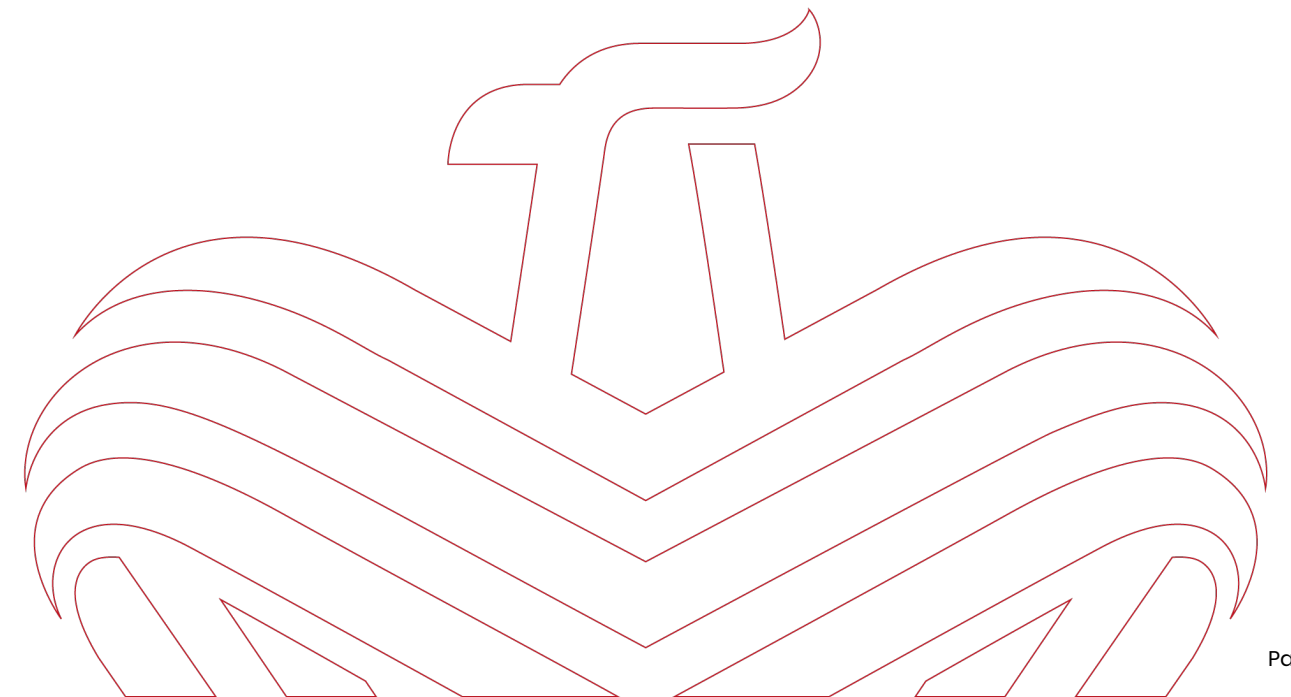

## About Liverpool

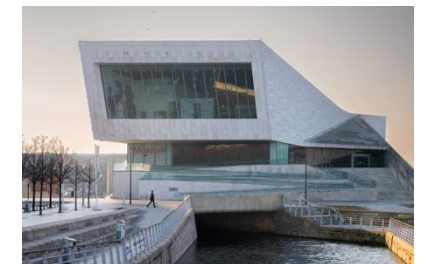

## The Venue

Our meeting will be held in two of these modern purpose built venues in the heart of Paddington Village, the knowledge quarter of the city, a short distance from each other. **All our workshops, SIGS, COPs, Posters, Catering, Networking and Exhibition will be located at the Spine, while our plenary sessions will be held in the Yoko Ono Lennon Centre.**

## The Spine

The Spine opened in 2021 and is the home to the education center for the Royal College of Physicians. Our breakout sessions and exhibition will be held in Spaces @ the Spine a purpose build conference facility on floors 12 and 13. This offers an integrated experience for our workshop and exhibition while also offering 360-degree panoramic views of the city from a technologically advanced and sustainably designed building. For plenary speaker sessions we move a 7-minute walk down the road to the Yoko Ono Lennon Lecture Theatre on the campus of the University.

**Our social events are being held in the Museum of Liverpool, St George's Hall and Liverpool Town Hall, all of which are located within the city center.** Delegates may prefer to book hotels within these environs. The Executive will be located at the Novotel Paddington Village just next door to the Spine for convenience.

The programme is structured so there will be no more than one transfer between these two venues per day.

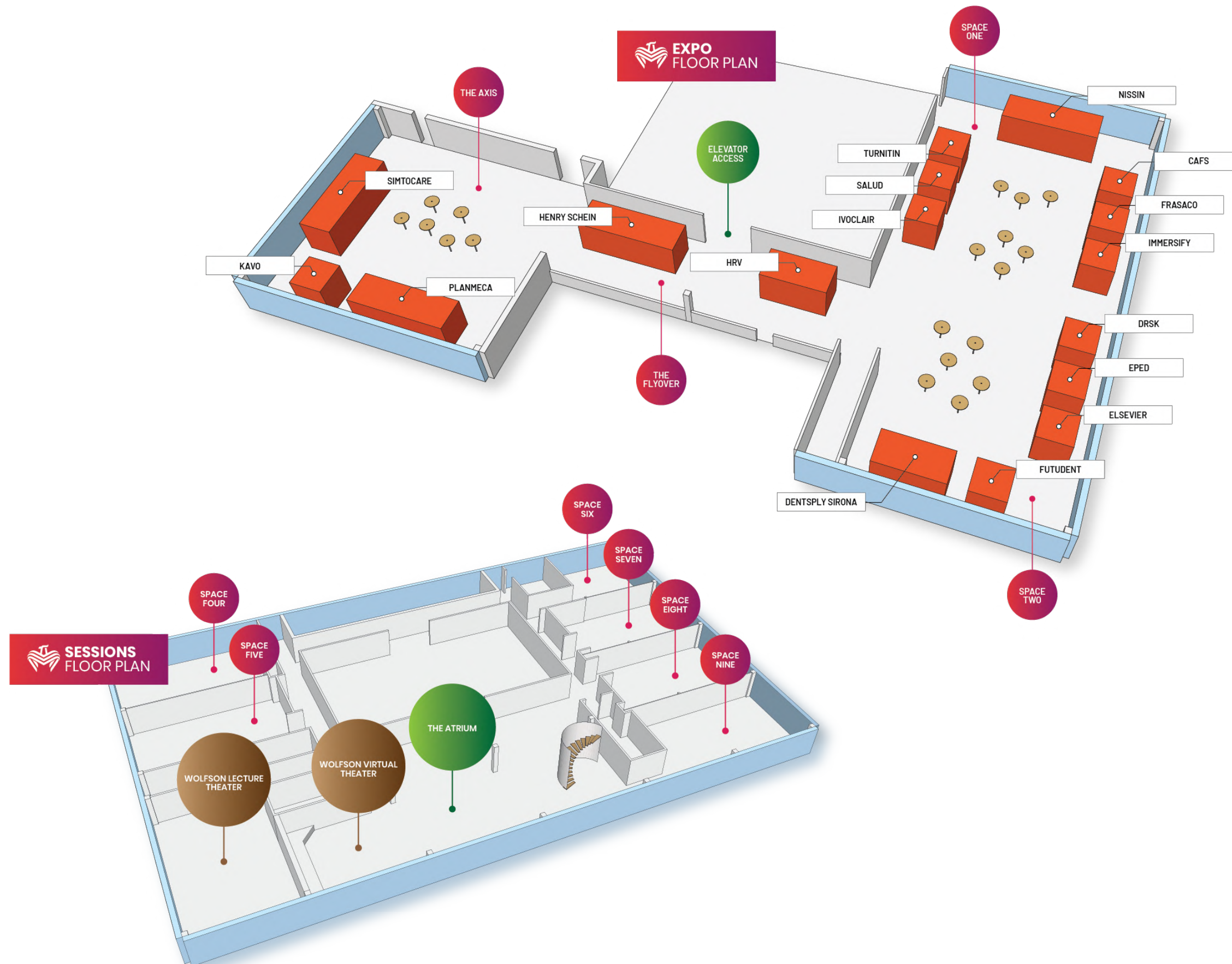

**Marta Adam**

President

European Dental Students Association

**Marta Adam** was born in 1997 in Zagreb, Croatia. She graduated from the School of Dental Medicine, University of Zagreb in 2022. Currently, she is working as a general dentist at a private polyclinic Aesthetica. She has joined EDSA (European Dental Students Association) in 2018, firstly as a Croatian Delegate, then as a Mobility Officer, General Secretary and now she is a President for the term 2022/2023.

During her studies, she actively participated in numerous projects of the Croatian Dental Students Association. In 2021, Marta published a paper entitled "Dental Students Discomfort and Anxiety During the First and the Second Lockdown Due to COVID-19 Pandemic at the School of Dental Medicine, University of Zagreb" in the journal Acta Stomatologica Croatica and "Antimicrobial Photodynamic Therapy in periodontology" in the student magazine Sonda.

She also won the Rector's Awards for socially useful work in the academic and wider community on the subject of the Geronto project 2019/2020 and EDSA Meeting Zagreb and the Rector's award for individual scientific and artistic work on the topic "Effectiveness of protective splints during the procedure of endotracheal intubation" She was also awarded the special Dean's award for international activities.

**Professor Katharine Boursicot, BSc, MBBS, MRCOG, MAHPE, SFH, FRSM** graduated from the University of London with an Honours BSc in Anatomy and MBBS from the Medical College of St Bartholomew's Hospital. She worked as a Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist at St Thomas', St Bartholomew's and Homerton Hospitals in London, with an Honorary Reader position at Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.

After studying at the Institute of Education in London, she became a full time medical educationalist, gaining experience and expertise in medical education and led the reform of assessment at the medical schools at Barts and the London, Cambridge University, St George's University of London, the Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine and Duke-NUS in Singapore.

In 2016, she founded HPAC, to provide high-quality courses on all aspects of assessment in health professions education, as well as consultancy and faculty development services. All our consultants have established track records of teaching, consultancy and research in a wide range of health professions education areas. They have extensive expertise in the pedagogy and best practice of design and development of curricula and assessments, quality assurance work and wide experience in the undergraduate and postgraduate education arenas.

She has published her research in the leading medical education journals, is an Associate Editor for the journals Advances in Health Sciences Education, BioMedCentral and is a regular reviewer for Medical Education, Medical Teacher, the BMJ, the Clinical Teacher, Higher Education Quarterly and Assessment and Evaluation in Higher Education. She is the Series Editor for the Oxford University Press companion volumes to their Handbooks of Medicine series (Oxford Assess and Progress series).

She currently sits on the Assessment Panel for the AMEE ASPIRE Awards, and led the Consensus Group on Performance Assessment for the Ottawa Conferences in 2010 and 2020. She has also led the ESMEA (Essential Skills in Medical Education: Assessment) course for AMEE since 2008.

**Professor Richard Fuller** is the Director of Christie Education in Manchester, UK, with an innovative portfolio of local, national and international education work focused on realising learner potential and improving healthcare outcomes, in association with the Manchester Cancer Research Centre and major partners including the University of Manchester.

This is underpinned by a substantial career in Health Professions Education (both nationally and internationally) and the development of sector-leading curricula, programmes of study and assessment systems in previous senior education roles at the Universities of Leeds and Liverpool which generated exciting new initiatives in curriculum design, mobile technology, assessment and personalised learning across health professions and the continuum of undergraduate and postgraduate practice. Richard practices clinically as a Consultant Stroke Physician and Geriatrician.

Richard's main research interests focus primarily on assessment, working with a cross institutional group of research colleagues, which has led to over 200 key outputs (significant journal papers; invited and peer reviewed presentations to learned societies and institutions; educational consultancy). This portfolio of work centres on the 'personalisation' of assessment, to support individual learner journeys, drawing on impact-based research including the application of intelligent assessment design in campus and workplace-based assessment formats, assessor behaviours, mobile technology delivered assessment and the impact of sequential testing methodologies. Richard publishes and speaks regularly at leading international medical education conferences, and is an active PhD supervisor, with current students focusing on assessment and curriculum research.

Richard holds a number of national/UK educational advisory roles, including acting as an assessment expert for the General Medical Council, and leadership of the GMC's Tests of Competence Panel. Richard is the current Chair of the ASPIRE to Excellence Panel in Health Professions Education Assessment, set up by the Association of Medical Education in Europe (<https://www.aspire-to-excellence.org/>), and additionally is a trustee, and member of the executive group of AMEE.

Prof Janusz is working with multiple educational organisations, including being the advisor for Association of Medical Schools in Europe (AMSE) and the AMEE Executive Committee member. He is the member of the Board of Directors of European Institute of Women's Health. Janusz is the external expert for multiple accreditation committees and the Associate Editor of the Medical Teacher Journal.



**Fotinos Panagakos**

Founding Dean  
School of Dental Medicine at Pacific Northwest  
University of Health Sciences in Yakima, WA

**Dr. Panagakos** received his DMD from UMDNJ-New Jersey Dental School (now Rutgers University School of Dental Medicine) and his Ph.D. in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology from UMDNJ-Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences (now the Rutgers University Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences) in 1992. In 1999, he received his Master's in Education from Seton Hall University; in 2007, he received his Master's in Business Administration from Lehigh University.

Dr. Panagakos served for 13 years as a full-time faculty member at New Jersey Dental School, serving in several administrative positions, including Group Practice Administrator, Director of Environmental Safety, and Associate Dean of Academic Affairs. He also maintained a private dental practice in Westfield and Newark, NJ, during this time. In June 2005, He joined the Colgate Palmolive Oral Care Clinical Research Department as an Associate Director. He worked at Colgate until September 2017, serving as the Global Director of Scientific Affairs from 2010 until he departed. In August 2018, Dr. Panagakos joined the West Virginia University School of Dentistry as the Associate Dean for Research, where he led the institution's research efforts. From July 2020 until May 2021, he served as the Interim Dean.

Since May 2022, Dr. Panagakos has been the Founding Dean of the School of Dental Medicine at Pacific Northwest University of Health Sciences in Yakima, WA. He has authored/co-authored over 88 peer-reviewed scientific research articles and has co-edited three dental science textbooks. His areas of research interest include the role of inflammation in oral and overall health, the impact of nutrition on oral health and wellness, and the impact of improved oral health on overall wellness
